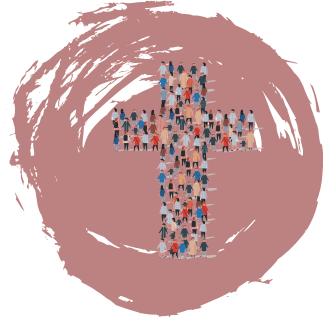





Discerning Leadership: From the Classroom to the Principalship
